UPCOMING BULK TRASH PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Bulk Trash Pick-Up Schedule: 3rd Monday of the Month:

June 19th July 17th August 21st

The following items will NOT be picked up and are NOT to be put out at curbside at any time:

Bulk Trash: Construction debris, including sheet rock, lumber, roof shingles, concrete, bricks, tires and e-waste (it is the homeowners' responsibility to see that construction debris, tires and e-waste are disposed of properly).

- Recycling:**
- Items must be separated and placed in the proper green and blue bins.
 - Plastic bags are not to be placed in bins.
 - Medical waste is not to be placed in bins and must be properly disposed of.

Trash is to be placed at curbside no earlier than the weekend prior to pick-up and no later than 7:00AM on the date of pick-up.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Street Light Outages – Please contact the Village Office to report any street lights that are not working properly.

Reminder to Dog Owners – In accordance with Village Code Chapter 65, Section 65-5-A(4), it is prohibited to allow your dog to defecate on public property without properly removing the dog waste immediately and **DISPOSED OF PROPERLY**. Violators may be subject to fines. Please take pride in our community and have respect for your neighbors by working together to keep it clean.

Requirement of House Numbers - To ensure proper/timely emergency response, house/building numbers are to be conspicuously displayed as follows: Residential buildings: no less than 3” in height; Nonresidential buildings: no less than 4” in height.

Garbage Collection – If your garbage, that has been duly and timely placed at curbside, is not picked up on the scheduled date, please notify the Village Office.

NOTE: Garbage will not be picked up on Monday, May 29th (Memorial Day). It will be picked up on Tuesday, May 30th.
