

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

VILLAGE OF HILLBURN, NEW YORK

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that sealed proposals will be received by the Village of Hillburn, Village Hall located at 31 Mountain Avenue, Hillburn, New York 10931, on or before Friday December 27, 2024 at 4:00 PM at such time any bids received will be opened and read aloud. The Village Board, at their next meeting will award the bid. Each bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly stating the contractor's name and address and the project name on the exterior of the envelope entitled:

VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK POND REPAIR

Base Bid -

The scope of work for the project will include the construction of a boulder wall, approximately 45 LF long by 6 feet high, within the pond to effectively reduce the pond size. Construction of approximately 200 LF of 2.5-inch diameter HDPE water line that will be connected through the boulder wall from the existing well to a point on the north bank of the pond for the purpose of providing an additional source of water to keep the pond full. A 2-inch electrical conduit with pull strings will be constructed for a future pond fountain and sensor (by others). The scope includes the construction of 1 manhole, modification of 2 catch basins, 1 outfall at the pond, and the construction of approximately 115 LF of 15-inch HDPE. Included in the scope of work is dewatering, or lowering the water level to facilitate the work.

The existing pond will be dredged approximately 1 foot, and to the extent necessary to supply suitable fill material for the newly created dry area behind the new wall in the northeast corner of pond. This is estimated at 700 CY. The material may be staged, and dewatered on site. Unsuitable material may remain in the Village at the 6 th Street compost area. 4-inch thick topsoil will be placed on top of this area, approximately 52 CY.

Included in the scope of work is placement and grading of this excavated material, topsoil and seeding of this newly created area, and topsoil and seed restoration of all disturbed areas within the park.

Alternate Bid 1 –

Modification of soils within the remaining wet pond area to reduce permeability by adding clay.

Alternate Bid 2 –

In lieu of dredging the pond, import suitable fill material, approximately 700 CY.

The Contract Documents may be examined and copies obtained at the Office of the Village Clerk during usual business hours. Copies of the Contract Documents may be obtained upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of fifty (\$50) dollars for each set. Checks shall be made payable to the Village of Hillburn. Alternately, a pdf of the contract documents may be obtained by contacting Eve Mancuso, PE at Mancuso.Eve@WSEInc.com free of cost.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, or bid bond executed by a surety company, in the amount of not less than (10) percent of the total amount of the proposal, conditioned that if the proposal is accepted, the bidder will enter into a contract for the work and that he will execute such further security as may be required for the faithful performance of the Contract.

All bids must meet the requirements of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and all other applicable federal, state and local statutes. Strict compliance with all State and Federal Labor Standards is mandatory. Minority and Women Owned Businesses are encouraged to submit bids. The successful bidder will be required to comply with all pertinent federal regulations. The lowest qualified bidder meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents will be awarded the bid.

Statement of Non-Collusion

Bidders on the Contract are required to execute non-collusion bidding certificates pursuant to Section 103d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

Please take further Notice that the Village Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all portions of the proposal, and to re-advertise for same, should it be in the best interest of the Village. The Village also reserves the right to reject any proposal that is informal, or waive any informality in the bidding document. No bidder may withdraw a bid within 30 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
