# <u>RESOLUTION Endorsing the Sale of Sewer District Property in the Village of Hillburn to the Land Conservancy of New Jersey for the Purpose of Preserving Cultural Resources of Value to the Ramapough Lunaape</u>

The following **RESOLUTION** was offered by Trustee O'Blenis and seconded by Trustee Tarantino who moved its adoption:

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hillburn as follows:

WHEREAS, the Rockland County Sewer District No. 1 ("Sewer District") caused the construction of the Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant ("AWTP") on property owned by it in the Village of Hillburn; and

**WHEREAS**, approximately 54.588 acres of the property acquired by the Sewer District for such purpose has been deemed to be excess property for sewer purposes, and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 371 of 2018, the Rockland County Legislature authorized the sale of the foregoing excess property: and

**WHEREAS**, the Ramapough Lunaape Nation has notified the Sewer District of the existence of important cultural resources on the property and wishes for the property to be preserved: and

**WHEREAS**, the Ramapough Lunaape Nation has contacted The Land Conservancy of New Jersey to assist with preserving the property: and

WHEREAS, The Land Conservancy of New Jersey has indicated its desire to acquire the property for the purpose of preserving the property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, Rockland County Sewer District No. 1, upon the recommendation of the Executive Director, has authorized the Sewer District to enter into an agreement with The Land Conservancy of New Jersey, for the conveyance of said property to The Land Conservancy of New Jersey in order to preserve the Property to protect the important Ramapough Lunaape Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hillburn concurs that the foregoing property contains important cultural resources for the Ramapough Lunaape Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hillburn is fully supportive of the conveyance of the property to The Land Conservancy of New Jersey for the purpose of preserving the important cultural resources of value to the Ramapough Lunaape Nation located on the property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hillburn that the Village of Hillburn fully supports and endorses the sale of the aforesaid property to The Land Conservancy of New Jersey for the purpose of preserving the cultural resources of value to the Ramapough Lunaape Nation.
