

Lead Hazard Remediation



Eligibility

If you meet the following requirements you may be eligible for assistance:

- Your home contains Lead Paint Hazards
- A child under six lives in, or spends a significant amount of time in the home (if owner-occupied).
- Your gross household income is no more than 80% of the median income for the County.
- There is current insurance on the property.
- There are no mortgage or tax arrears on the property.

Most Common Services

Window & Door Replacement

Certified contractors replace windows and doors to reduce the amount of lead dust produced through normal use.

Exterior Siding

Existing siding is replaced or enclosed to prevent lead from paint from contaminating outdoor spaces.

Other Repairs

The Office of Community Development has been awarded additional funding to complete health and safety repairs not involving lead hazards. To be eligible for this funding there must be lead hazards in the home.
