-RC Dept. of Health - Lead and Copper Rule Revisions - Lead Service Line Inventory Information

<u>Youth Center – RC Health Dept. – Food Service Establishment Inspection</u> – Supt. Conklin reported that the inspection was held on 5/19/2023. The following issues, as stated in the Summary Report received 5/22/2023, will be repaired: leaks in kitchen hand wash sink; and women's bathroom sinks.
