FUNDING/GRANTS – Ongoing Projects:

<u>Veterans Memorial Park Pond</u> – Bid specifications are being finalized. Funding for this project includes the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and a SAM Grant.

Construction of DPW Garage on 5^{th} St – Bids for this project will be received on January 9, 2024. This project is being partially funded through a SAM Grant and existing BAN Appropriation. A Bond Resolution for the balance of funding was adopted on 11/14/2023. This building will house village equipment and keep it protected from the weather.

6th St Culvert Repair – Damages caused by Hurricane Ida - Funding: Federal & State grants (FEMA DR4615). Bids for project were received on 11/14/2023.

REMINDERS/REGULATIONS

<u>Leaf Pick-Up</u> – The deadline to place <u>loose</u> leaves at curbside is December 8, 2023. DO NOT PLACE LEAVES IN THE ROADWAY. This not only obstructs traffic but can cause hazardous conditions. Twigs/branches are not to be mixed in with the piles of leaves. Bagged leaves can continue to be placed at curbside for pick up on Mondays. Free leaf bags are available at the Village Office.

<u>Bulk Trash Pick-Up Schedule</u> – <u>Monday, December 18, 2023, Tuesday, January 16, 2024</u> & <u>Tuesday, February 20, 2024</u> (*Contingent on weather conditions)

Do not place trash at curbside any earlier than the weekend before the scheduled pick-up date. Once the DPW has collected bulk trash from your street, you CANNOT place any additional bulk trash at curbside. Construction debris will NOT be collected and is not to be placed at curbside.

Household Trash

Garbage must be placed in garbage bags and put inside proper receptacles. (No loose garbage to be put in receptacles) Cans should not to be placed at curbside any earlier than the night before the scheduled pick-up date and are to be removed from curbside the day of pick-up.

Seasonal Parking Restriction – In accordance with Local Law 2, 2016 (adopted 5/12/16) parking on Village streets is prohibited as follows:

- -Any time when snow is accumulating on the roadway.
- -Any time after snow has accumulated on roadway and before said snow has been cleared from roadways.
- -Between the hours of 12:00AM and 6:00AM, if snowfall has been forecast by the National Weather Service.
